1. **Apologies for Absence**

Apologies were received from Caroline Sargent (Penwith Council), Colin Philp (Hayle Resident), Sandra Easterbrook (Hayle Resident) and Dave Clarke (County Council)

2. **Chairman - Welcome to the Meeting**

The Chairman, Joe Colliver, welcomed everyone to the meeting and passed around an agenda which, because this was only our second meeting, needed to be flexible. He explained that Dave Clarke would not be able to attend this meeting but would be at the next one to talk about cycle tracks etc.

3. **Cycling**

Jacqui Head and Jeff Turk had discussed cycling in the Hayle area and had come up with the following which they hoped could be worked up into Projects :

a. The Walkway - they hoped that this could be used by both pedestrians and cyclists. As no funding is available for this project at present, it will have to remain as a future project.

b. Cycle Route 3 - Hayle to St Erth - They considered this to be quite a dangerous area and suggested that a project be worked up to make the route along the River Bank. It was decided to await the arrival of Dave Clarke who may be able to advise on this.

c. Cycle Parking Stands - they considered that these stands were important and that they should be sited throughout the shopping areas from Foundry to Copperhouse.

d. Safety of Cyclists - Penpol Terrace and Copperhouse were considered to be dangerous areas for cyclists as they were on the highway and at risk when motorists were trying to jump past them.

4. **Bus, Train and Public Transport**

Jeremy Joslin briefed the group on "Silver Service" and its effects on Hayle including their plan to have buses from all the Holiday Camps in the area travelling to St Erth Station. It was agreed to have further discussions on this item at the meeting after next.

Jeff Turk pointed out that the Bus Stop (Eastbound) in Copperhouse should be moved from Beatrice Terrace to as near to the Co-op Entrance as possible for the convenience of Shoppers. This will also need to be dealt with by the Town Council.

Owen Philp raised the problem of Articulated Lorries travelling to and from Leedstown, and at speed, which made the very narrow road unsafe for other road users. This brought in the argument about a slip road at Tolroy but Owen seemed to think that this would make matters worse. This will also need to be dealt with by the County Council.

Tim Andrews gave an update on Local Transport.

5. **Date and Time of the Next Meeting**

It was agreed to hold the next meeting at 7.30 on Wednesday 21st March 2007. You will be notified of the venue.

6. **Election of a Vice Chairman**

Everyone agreed, and Earl Bryant accepted, the position of Vice Chairman of this Delivery Group.
