### **3. Matters arising from previous meeting**

Special Constabulary. There will be a local campaign aimed at attracting recruits. It was suggested that we could specifically target clubs etc that may have appropriate candidates

Dog fouling. The two PCSOs in Hayle will be able to issue tickets for dog fouling. Their names have already been put forward to PDC to get them authorised. Training will be carried out by PDC

Speeding. The meeting was given the latest figures. There had been good press regarding the operation held.

Tamsyn has now left the neighbourhood team for CID, the vacancy has been advertised.

Lighting at the Skate Park. Still ongoing. There is scope for good media coverage with the 1<sup>st</sup> anniversary approaching. John Bennett undertook to progress.

The number of burglaries to sheds and garages were a concern especially at the Loggans end of town and at the holiday camps.

Speed signs in Mellanear Road- Are they in the most appropriate location/ Should there be an advance warning sign.

Speed on the Causeway/junction with Chenhalls road. Is it time to review the speed.

Foundry Square – driving parking issues when the works is being carried out. Can we try to reduce the number of lorries coming through the town?

Security light at SEF on Leedstown Rd. Danger to drivers.
