The Towans Partnership has agreed to take on one or more of the MCTi Hayle Area Plan projects.
They relate to access and management of the Towans and beaches and it is important for proper planning to have as much actual data as possible.

Simply put, we would like to have all of the data available and, if you have anything additional that I have missed in the list below, please add it.
Here is what we think is available:

- Car park data for Gwithian and Hayle car parks going back as many years as you can - to give us an idea of the number of visitors and the approximate spread over time and season.
- Beach data: estimates of beach use by area, incidents, surfing, kite surfing, rubbish on beach, helicopter call outs, medical interventions, vehicles on beach, horses, dogs in prohibited areas, etc.
- Dog warden data. Number of complaints, where from, tickets issued and where, etc.

Finally, and you may get a formal request from the Towans Partnership, could you keep open 10am on 20 June to attend the next Towans Partnership Meeting at PEI in Hayle? A number of important issues are under consideration and it would be worthwhile to have your input at this time.
