PESCE

Rob gave an update on the progress of the PESCE Project. Following a meeting with the Towans Partnership there is a need for agreement to control the beach and beach activities. There should be a trial period to assess what activities could take place and where. This would become critical in the summer period. The beach owners are due to meet in March and it is hoped that PESCE would be a main player in deciding the outcome. Some owners want a system of licences to allow access and to determine what activities can be allowed on their land

Rob stressed that the legal position of all concerned was very important...The meeting of the sub group had been very positive and will reconvene in the near future.

Bob Mims asked if the Watersports project was still part of PESCE's plans as planning consent for that project was running out of time. Rob affirmed that the plan was still included in PESCE's remit.

Towans Activity Centre

Claire William's plan has been discussed with her at Penwith District Council. Charlotte Chadwick stressed the need for a business plan and details of costing. There has been no contact since that meeting and success will probably depend on scaling down original plans to some degree. Charlotte agreed to contact Claire regarding free business advice.

Whitewater Sports Centre

Ray has been in touch with a developer and the project is ongoing.

Website

Cllr Chris Head said there had been some progress on the website but that business commitments meant that he was not able to devote enough time to make the site fully operational. Charlotte Chadwick mentioned that a group of students at Penwith College had shown interest in helping with the project. Chris mentioned the need for funding to provide a suitable site; Charlotte agreed to contact the students when Chris was able to give them a detailed

brief to work to. Chris agreed to supply this, hopefully by the 29th of February. Funding the website will form part of this group's remit.

Hayle Logo

The logo has been well received generally and a letter of thanks had been sent to Martin Nixon. Roger had written to Hayle Town Council on behalf of this group suggesting that they take over ownership of the logo, as they are a statutory body providing that HAPP retains the management of it. Martin had agreed allow the transfer to take place and was prepared to provide the necessary paperwork. John has been in touch with Martin regarding the transition process.

Charlotte pointed out that Falmouth and Saltash had used the logo on things like carrier bags as a means of publicity.
