Youth Update

Ellis Park Shelter Discussed it has already been agreed as to where the shelter will go and this must go ahead. No further discussions needed.

Cllr John Pollard outlined the History Umbrella Group Harvey House will be collecting all memorabilia for the history archives. They will be contacting schools to start projects about their own history. The archive centre will be at the Old Brewery building which is being renovated and St Austell Brewery are going to lease it at a peppercorn rent. This will be volunteer lead.

N Skues Reported that the Youth Centre is only open one evening per week. It is used four days a week for non-school attendants. They have gone back to basics assessing their stock of resources and trying to build a solid foundation on which to work. This includes sorting out the infrastructure looking at buildings, staffing hours and the quality of funding

M Tanner asked when the shelter at Ellis Park would be erected.

D.Webb This should be in July although more people are objecting,

Cllr J Pollard pointed out that every opportunity had been given to these objections in many previous meeting, but they had not come forward. It had now as stated above be on the original site.

Emergency Update Copper Terrace Site.

Bob Mims distributed Documents and Plans to all present. He will be having a meeting with David Clough who informed him that County seemed interested, of course that maybe where some of the funding could come from.

Mark Breock Stated in view of the expansion of Hayle it would be foolish not to have a fire station here and would be more than happy to look at this sharing of facilities with the other services. At the moment three fire stations share with the coastguards

Ian Penhaligon Commented the Doctors are the major players incorporating a polyclinic, this should be down to Bodriggy Surgery. Also picking up the short fall i.e. Serco Doctors Services.

Bob Mims said the Doctors have no problem working with other services 24/7 in emergencies quest. One thing to note all service drains have to be self-contained. CCTV coverage was also mentioned.

Cllr J Pollard Great. All in favour of concept but the site chosen at the moment has planning for housing and would the people living there be happy with 24 hour movement of emergency

vehicles, this would lead to more traffic movement making it a disadvantage for fire and ambulances to get onto the main road and also noise levels from the sirens.

Mark Breock Fire. They would prefer the Mellanear end of Hayle. The site behind Copper Terrace is not the place for it. It had also been said ING were making a provision for a Fire Station but this could present the same problem.

D Raymer Is Copper Terrace in a flood plain.

Bob Mims No the road is but the site is above

Henry Blakely Muted moving West Cornwall Hospital to a new A30 Tolroy roundabout junction and putting all the services there except medical centre as this would be to far out. Put pressure on Highways to instigate this new roundabout.

Mark Breock Review for the fire cover across the county is to take place mid Autumn.

Cllr J Pollard The A30 junction has been turned down by the County Council.

D Raymer We need to put the idea forward.

Cllr J Coombe In Principle this is O.K and can go forward onto an alternative site if required.
Bob to see David Clough.

Mark Breock offered to take some on a visit to a retained Fire Station to see what is required.

It was voted an agreed to go back to the management meeting.

Cllr John Coombe then went on to the wanton damage that has happened in Hayle over the last Two weeks together with the intimidation on elderly residents on the Tremorvah estate.

Inspector J Phillips This has top priority and they know who the culprits are.

Dave Raymer requested the police to go to the Day Care Centre to reassure the elderly that things will be sorted out.

Youth Service is not the answer for these youngsters they are too far gone.

J Wallis Grant Application. Report on Hayle District Bowling Club they now have 57 male players and 23 female + maybe another 5. They are now fundraising for the building of the new club house and the furnishings. It will then be able to offer short mat bowling for the youngsters which at the moment takes place at the Rugby Club. Problems may occur with the greens due to vandalism by youngsters which could shorten the life of the carpet, this costs £40.000 pounds to renew. Would the council look to putting in CCTV for this and Ellis Park?

Cllr J Coombe Costings out to installers regarding CCTV i.e. changing positions and camera at Ellis Park

Craig Walker What's been done to speak to theses youngsters

Jon Wallis We had an Open Day to encourage youngsters to play seven young people started to play then finished. Wrote to all schools Ludgvan school coming to play.

Cllr John Pollard Suggested Sunday morning sessions urge to talks encourage youngsters to attend.

Delia Webb Roll out sports activities in the holidays.

Cllr John Coombe Grant application for J Wallis re Bowling Club new Club House endorsed by HAPP applying for maximum £1000. HarryBlakely proposed Bob Mims Seconded all in favour. Passed to management team.

Grant Application Youth Centre working with Youth Cornwall. Have a very good attendance but need new games tables tennis and pool tables could be reconditioned to give them a sense of pride and trying to change the culture. Staff levels need to be high to keep control also that we can stay open longer, working in partnership with schools and holding after school sessions together with running their own café on a wednesday night so we asking for the maximum of £1000. Proposed by Bob Mims Seconded Harry Blakely.
