Grant applications

There were grant applications from 4 groups

1 Hayle Carnival Group

2. St Erth Youth Café

3. Hayle Table Tennis for Fun

4 Hayle in Bloom

! John Pollard spoke on behalf of Hayle Carnival Group who wanted £110 to buy 2 banners which would be re-usable. The application was granted unanimously by the committee. PDC want Mr. Horwell to get a quote from a signmaker.

2. Alex Sheffield of St Erth Youth Café asked for £864.47 to provide facilities for 13-16 year olds at St Erth parish church. This was unanimously passed by the committee.

3. Hayle Table Tennis For Fun. Which is held in Hayle Methodist Church Hall applied for £300 for equipment. The request was granted

4. Margaret Tanner spoke about Hayle in Bloom

Her intention was to ask for a grant for two trees for Foundry Square. However as another group had already applied for this it was decided to withdraw the application and re-apply at a later date for another project to improve Hayle

Any other business

David Raymer mentioned that there was sufficient funding for another eighteen months for Youth Cornwall

John Pollard said that the plans for the youth shelter in Ellis Park had been passed

David Clough was in the process of collating the Hayle Action Plan

He had received 180 letters plus a lot of questionnaires.

The key issues are.

1.What are the requirements for Hayle apart from housing

2 Do we need a Fire Station

3, What are the infrastructure requirements

4.Do we need a junior school. Is there a key site

5.Who will take the final decision on these issues.

6.The Government Office will need final plans by December
