2. Chairman's welcome

DM welcomed everyone to the meeting.

3. Connor Downs Traffic Management Update – Ray Tovey

Ray Tovey gave the background to this item. He said that traffic through Connor Downs had greatly increased and effect was the village is being spilt in two by speeding vehicles.

Efforts to obtain a pedestrian crossing had failed. Initially, CCC Highways had said that if money could be found we could have a crossing. Budgets were found, but now it can't happen as it does not meet CCC Highways' PV squared formula. Efforts to slow down the traffic had also failed and it was an on-going police problem.

Ray had brought this item to this group to seek advice on the way forward.

A general discussion took place. It was clear help was needed to make road safety measures happen. Ray was right to bring this item forward, but as no local authority officers were present, it needed to be raised again at a future meeting.

4. St Erth-Hayle Multi-Use Trail and other links – Mick Hanley

Mick Hanley tabled a paper outlining the walking and cycling network in the local area, particularly between St Erth and Hayle. This item will come back to the next meeting for further discussion.
