Minutes of meeting held on Tuesday 21 September 2010, 7.00 pm at Passmore Edwards Institute

3. MATTERS ARISING - ACTIONS outstanding

4. PROGRESS

Simon handed round drafts to show how the maps and their borders were developing. It was agreed that a great deal of progress had been made in a short time and that the balance was right. Various colour schemes were looked at but it was felt that those used on the drafts was good incorporating the Hayle cyan brand colour. It was pointed out that areas had been allocated on the wildlife map for illustrations/text to be incorporated for Gwinear/Gwithian and St Erth. The background/border of these areas to be colour branded mid green for Gwinear-Gwithian and light sandy for St Erth.

5. Contents Specifics

➤ Hayle Town Map Heritage and History

Text

- i. Space has been allocated which governs how much text can be incorporated.
- ii. Arrows to be put on to indicate direction for Gwinear-Gwithian, St Erth etc
- iii. The history gathered together by Greta to be circulated for reading through and checked (sub group John Bennett/Georgina Schofield/John Pollard). Short text on map with longer version available on the website – short text to be concentrated on for present.
- iv. The Millponds walk to include text on the Cathy Turtles.

Transport

- v. Details of bus times raise difficulties as timetabling is subject to change and there are some seasonal routes. It was suggested that contact information and web site addresses for buses be given and nothing but the very main bus services included with only primary bus stops depicted, Copperhouse and Foundry. Seasonal routes could be clearly denoted by colour coding. Lesley Barlow to be contacted to find out which services are guaranteed to run. The remaining space could be used for illustration of why it is important and good to use public transport and encourage car free days.
- vi. Cycle routes were discussed eg The Cornish Way (Route 3), and although limited details are to be obtained from Sustrans

Walks

- vii. Greta has completed Town and Towans walks. The Millponds/Plantation/Carnsew pool walk is to be a shorter walk without the inclusion Carnsew Pool.

Illustrations

- viii. The “character” to be animated was discussed with the preference given to the curlew or adder. A final decision has not been made.

ix. Illustrations for consideration: tramway down Angarrack Hill, Crimean Gun, Cunaide stone .

The draft illustrations depicting buildings and life scenes were very well received.

➤ **Hayle Area Map Wildlife**

The content for the boxes Gwinear-Gwithian and St Erth were discussed. .Suggestions included the bridge, old school room and church (Grade 1 Listed) for St Erth and Gwithian church with the explosion at Dynamite Towns in the background. It was agreed that:

- i. John Bennett would supply a copy of text on the explosion
- ii. Duncan Thurnell-Read would ask Gwinear-Gwithian Parish Council for their preference for inclusion
- iii. Claire Casey would ask St Erth Parish Council for their preference for inclusion
- iv. It was suggested Claire contact Andrew McDouall, Natural England, with regard to further wild life suggestions

Representation of the National Trust at Godrevy point and was discussed. It was agreed that seal cove be included in the illustration although strictly out of Hayle area. The Neolithic and Celtic fields should be included.

➤ **General**

Simon and Greta will populate a list of Useful Telephone numbers which can then be agreed upon. Suggestions for inclusion were Town and Parish Clerks, and usual emergency numbers.

The website is gradually being pieced together and nearer a point for presenting. It is hoped that all the "Discover" projects will be on one portal site with one licence fee in the near future.

There is now a good mix of birds but still a shortage of mammals. It was suggested that rabbits on the dunes be included as they help the dunes by their grazing which allows other things to grow. There are also red foxes, badgers, hedgehogs. Not a mammal but slow worms are also prevalent.

Finally, it was pointed out that logos need to be included eg Hayle Town Council, Hayle Area Partnership, Walkers are Welcome, World Heritage Site and those required by the WCLAG grant,

John Bennett commended Simon for having made splendid progress.

6. Any Other Business

It was confirmed that the meeting with WCLAG had been arranged for 2.00 pm, Thursday 14, October at Hayle Town Council offices. It was suggested that a copy of letter of agreement from WCLAG be obtained and forwarded to John Bennett and SR Studio prior to the meeting to check on which outputs will be required.

Further details on recycling Information needs to be obtained from Cornwall Council through Veryan Jones.

Sponsorship has been received from Sheila Goldsworthy, Truthwall Farm, which will be represented on the map.

Duncan Thurnell- Read requested a copy of the Minutes from meeting of 19th July be forwarded to him.
