Next meetings:

**Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> January 2008– Heritage, Culture and Env. –Passmore Edwards – 7.30**

This group have been investigating: **culture** (they perceive a need for a registry of events in the area), **environment** (they have linked with the Towans Partnership and have discussed a number of environmental issues) and **heritage** (they are developing a town trail and investigating project ideas in Copperhouse)

**Traffic and Transport –Date to be confirmed - Passmore Edwards Inst. – 7.30**

As part of the Harbour Development Plan, ING will have to submit a 'Traffic Impact Study'. This meeting will provide an opportunity for the community to review, discuss and debate that study – views that will inform the District Council and the planning process. As we still await the submission of the Study (and the plan) the date will be fixed when we are sure the necessary papers will be available. The Streetscape sub-group also continues to meet regularly.

**Monday 21<sup>st</sup> January – Business and Enterprise – Hayle Day Care Centre – 7.30**

This group continues to develop the idea of a Penwith Centre of Excellence for 'extreme' sports, watersports facilities and activity centres. They have now recommended the image for Hayle's logo and will develop a new web site based on this. The next meeting will enable SWERDA to provide a presentation on the Wave Hub project, an evening that we hope will inform and interest our community- please note the change from our usual venue.

**Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> January – Community Well-being – Hayle Day Care Centre – 7.30**

The group heard of the problems of staffing the Youth Club and representatives will meet some of the youngsters at the Hayle Youth project before Christmas. The group has also met with and received reports from representatives of 'emergency' services. Sister Maureen reported to the last meeting about the progress at St. Michaels and St Julia,s. She reported that morale at the hospital and Marie Therese House was much improved as resourcing had been improved. The next meeting will focus on the work of Hayle Day Care Centre and the Macmillan Nurses.
