Penwith District Council is preparing its new **Local Development Framework**. This is a series of planning documents which will direct the location and form of development in Penwith over the next 20 years. One document is the **Hayle Area Action Plan** which will guide development, such as housing, employment and community facilities, to where and when it is needed, building on the work of the Hayle Area Plan Delivery Groups. David Clough, a Policy Officer at the Council, has been attending Delivery Group meetings to help identify and understand issues which are important to the future of Hayle. The Council recently carried out consultation on an initial **Issues & Options** paper covering matters relevant to the District as a whole, and is required to produce a similar document relating specifically to the Hayle area. An informal '**open evening**' has therefore been arranged for anyone involved in the Partnership to simply drop in and meet David and other colleagues from the Council and have an input into the process. Apart from being an opportunity to pass on comments about relevant issues, one of the aims of the evening will be to try to 'map out' broad areas or specific sites which people feel are suitable (or not) for future development, together with the infrastructure that is needed to support it. This is an exciting chance for the community to inform, influence and shape future Council policy. **Please come!**
