

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE COMMUNITY WELL-BEING HELD AT THE DAY CARE CENTRE ON TUESDAY THE 25TH MARCH 2008

J.C Opened the meeting welcoming Ian Penhaligan from the Ambulance Service

1& 1 Appointment of Chairman and Vice Chairman Dave Raymer proposed both Chairman Cllr John Coombe and Vice Chairman Bob Mims should continue. Vote carried all were in agreement.

B.Mims continued with the update on the emergency services Ian Penhaligan was sole representative from the ambulance service no other services attended.

All emergency services were asked if they could operate from where they were for the next 20 years. The answer was no they would not be able to cope more room was needed.

Bob has drawn up a document for the Proposed Combined Emergency Service Centre for Hayle Area 2006-2026 these were handed out at the meeting should you require a further copy please get in touch with the Chairman. One location for consideration was the old R.J.K site although it was originally for housing this now seems to be open ended.

Dave Raymer questioned if an Architect had been consulted or was this purely Bobs proposal i.e. cost of buying the site, plans and cost of construction also this is in a conservation area.

B Mims explained these were his plans at the moment after he had consulted the services and asked for all their requirements, which he has collated and put in the proposal draft. A feasibility study would have to be set up as regards to funding involving all the services plus the Regional Development Board.

D Raymer said this kind of project was looked at in the Ludgvan area some time ago, which did not come to fruition maybe they still had some figures and ideas that may be of help in the future. There would also be the impact on the surrounding area regarding 24-hour services with traffic movement. Consultation would need to be implemented to ask for their views.

R.J This is also on a flood plain.

J.C Apologised for the absence of PDC officers they will be here for the April meeting. The Shelter at the Ellis Park has been ordered and will be erected shortly.

M.T This will be facing the road so that the police can monitor the situation it has solar lighting plus music set at one level. Cllr Coombe and Mrs Tanner are going to Hayle Community School to speak to the young people and explain that this shelter has cost between £6000 and £7000 and it is up to them to look after it. Should this be come vandalised then it will be removed.

Both J Wallis and Dave Raymer have great reservations regarding this shelter but as Cllr Coombe stated we have to give the young people a chance to prove them selves. Dave Raymer suggested perhaps the Youth Leader could also become involved and communicate with the youngsters to respect this area.

M.T It is only the minority that cause trouble. Perhaps we could have an opening ceremony.

J,C Congratulated the Day Care Centre on their new conservatory this makes it one of the best in the county and does our senior citizens proud. Also congratulations to Mr Wallis as the new Club House for the Bowling Green has been funded and should be finished by the end of the year.

R.W HAPP Have £20000 in grants for your assoc to apply for. This will be in the form of £1000 per assoc so get your forms and fill them in.

J.S,N Disappointed that nothing seems to be happening everything seems to have come to a stand still. The trouble is we are all going for the same money which takes an awful lot of time and effort as Dave Raymer has remarked the conservatory for the day centre has taken 3-4 years we are only a very small area and only get the crust of money available lets hope that when ING get in to gear things may evolve from this . All these things will not happen over night it took 15 years for the skate park to be up and running.
